- INTERNATIONAL TAEKWON-DO FEDERATION (ITF)

REGISTRATION FEE

- **25 EUR** FOR THE COMPETITORS REGISTERED IN FIGHTS OR FORMS
- **35 EUR** FOR THE COMPETITORS REGISTERED IN FIGHTS AND FORMS
IT HAS TO BE PAYED BEFORE THE WEIGHING

FIGHT DURATION

- QUALIFICATION FIGHTS 2x2 MIN
- FINAL FIGHTS 2x2 MIN

SPARING FIGHTS

JUNIORS HAVE TO BE OVER 13 AND UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE

- GIRLS: - 45kg , - 50kg , - 55kg , - 60kg , + 60kg
- BOYS: - 52kg , - 58kg , - 63kg , - 70kg , + 70kg

- FEMALE: - 52kg , - 58kg , - 63kg , - 70kg , + 70kg
- MALE: - 54kg , - 63kg , - 71kg , - 80kg , + 80kg

FORM – PATTERNS - only BLACK Belts!!!

- I DAN from CHON-JI to GE-BAEK
- II DAN from CHON-JI to JUCHE
- III DAN from CHON-JI to CHOI YONG
- IV DAN from CHON-JI to MOON-MOO

IN PRELIMINARY CONTEST THE COMPETITORS TAKE ONLY THE CHOSEN FORM WHICH IS REFEREED BY SMALL FLAGS.

IN THE FINAL CONTEST THE COMPETITORS TAKE THE OBLIGATORY AND THE CHOSEN FORM WHICH ARE REFEREED BY ESTIMATION SLIPS.

REFEREES

- ALL CLUBS HAVE TO PROVIDE THE REFEREES
 - 1 TO 10 COMPETITOR CLUB HAS TO HAVE ONE REFEREE. IF NOT, THE PENALTY IS 50 EUR.
 - OVER 20 COMPETITOR CLUB HAS TO HAVE TWO REFEREES. IF NOT, THE PENALTY IS 100 EUR.
- EACH REFEREE IS PAYED 50 EUR (III. dan and IV. dan), 30 EUR (II. dan and below) AND HE GETS LUNCH AND A REFEREE SHIRT THAT HE IS GOING TO WEAR AT THE CONTEST.
**Referees will be payed only if they work on Patterns and Fights!*

PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- EACH COMPETITOR HAS TO HAVE HIS OWN PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT WHICH HAS TO MEET ITF REGULATIONS.
- WITH THE REGISTRATION EACH COMPETITOR IS BOUND TO COMPETE ON HIS OWN ACCOUNT AND IS ACQUAINTED THAT IN THE CASE OF INJURY THE ORGANIZER IS NOT RESPONSIBLE.

COMPLAINTS

COMPLAINTS ARE POSSIBLE NO LATER THAN IN FIVE MINUTES TIME AFTER THE FINISHED FIGHT. THE COMPLAINT MAY BE WRITTEN ONLY ON THE OFFICIAL FORM AND BEFORE HANDING IN 50 EUR FEE HAS TO BE PAYED.

AWARDS

- CUPS FOR THE 1st, 2nd, 3rd AND 4th PLACE.
- FOR THE FIRST PLACE THE COMPETITOR GETS THE REMUNERATION WHICH IS 20% OF MONEY COLLECTED BY CATEGORIES (SENIORS ONLY), JUNIORS WILL GET PRACTICAL AWARD.
